SPONSORSHIP

East Coast CORE (Collaboration of Revenue Cycle Epic Users) is a professional development organization dedicated to Epic users across the East Coast who are either existing users or in the process of implementing Epic. The purpose is to increase knowledge and build a network around the Epic application, focusing mainly on Cadence, Prelude, PB and HB Billing. East Coast CORE hosts two meetings per year in the Spring and Fall. Our goal is to continue to grow and expand our knowledge and experiences by attending the various presentations developed for Epic users and by Epic users. There are about 40 different organizations represented at each meeting.

Sponsorship Details:

- We generally engage four Sponsors per meeting. The Sponsorship fee covers the event costs, event space, and the two networking events as there is no conference fee for attendees.
- Each Sponsor organization is permitted to send three representatives to the meeting. If space permits, more representatives may be able to be accommodated.
- Sponsor representatives are welcome to introduce their company and how it impacts Epic clients briefly during the opening introduction and for five minutes at the end of the first day of the conference, before the Networking Event.
- Each Sponsor has an opportunity to provide promotional items as well as a one-page informational sheet about their organization in the welcome bags distributed to meeting attendees at Registration. In the past, Sponsors have provided pens, pad-folios, phone chargers, reusable water bottles, etc.
- Before the meeting, each Sponsor will receive a list of the organizations and job titles of our registered attendees. At the meeting, each Sponsor will receive the full list of attendees, including names and contact information; this level of detail will not be disclosed until the conference.
- Your company logo will be displayed on the East Coast CORE website with a hyperlink to your organization's website for convenience.

We currently have a wait list for Sponsors. We do try to diversify our Sponsor organizations by type and service (i.e. we try not to include companies that offer similar services, like two banking institutions) in order to optimize the experience and investment.
